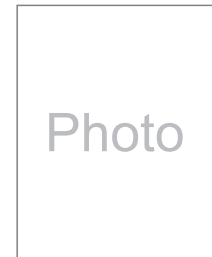

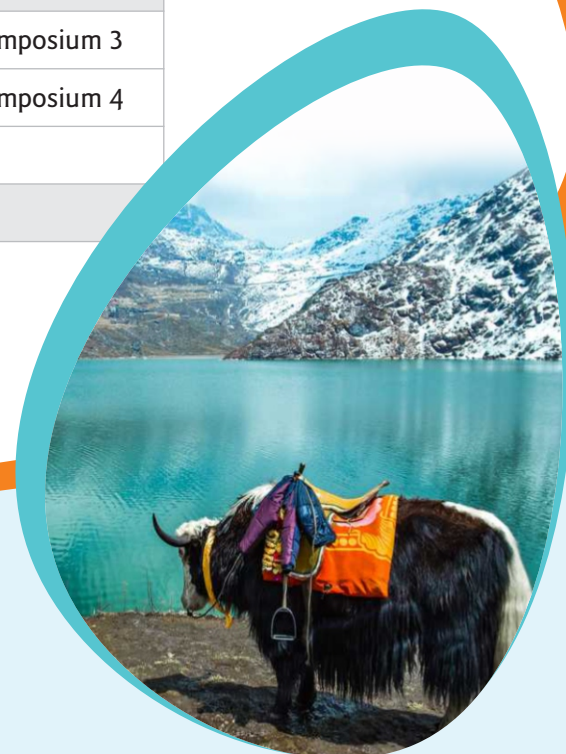

AWARDS PAPERS

- 1. Bombay Psychiatric Society Silver Jubilee Award (BPSS):** Best Paper will be forwarded to the ANCIPS 2024 as nomination from East Zone to contest for the BPSS Award. It is open to all members of IPS, East Zone.

2. The first page should contain only the title of the paper, authors name and the place of research. These particulars except the title should not appear anywhere else in the paper.
3. The oral presentation has to be done by the author or any one of the authors, all of whom must be members of IPS Eastern Zonal Branch. Time allowed for presentation will be 8 minutes to be followed by 2 minutes of discussion.
4. The paper should be prepared as per guidelines laid for preparing a research paper in Indian Journal of Psychiatry (www.indianjpsychiatry.org) the official publication of the Indian Psychiatric Society.
5. The participant should be registered for the conference under appropriate categories.





ORATIONS

DR. L. P. VERMA ORATION AWARD

This oration award is instituted in memory of the Late Dr. L. P. Verma, a senior fellow of the society. The oration will be delivered at the Annual Conference of the IPS-Eastern Zonal Branch.

Rules for the Oration award are as follows

- I. The Oration will be declared one year in advance at the Annual Conference of IPS Eastern Zonal Branch (CEZIPS) and will be delivered at the subsequent CEZIPS.
- II. Any Life Fellow of IPS Eastern Zonal Branch can propose the name of any other Life Fellow of the Society, who is above 45 years of age on the 30th June of the year of nomination, for the Oration Award
- III. The proposal including age proof and soft copies of the bio data of the nominee must be submitted send to the email id and WhatsApp account of The Chairman, Awards Committee, IPS, East Zone, Dr. Rajesh Kumar, email id - **kartavyarajesh2003@gmail.com** • **+91 9871554629**

Last date of submission – **15th September 2023**. The participant must confirm the receipt of the content over telephone to The Chairman, Award Committee, IPS, EAST ZONE. The nomination must be accompanied by written consent of the nominee.

IV. Assessment Criteria:

- a) Seniority, Recognition and Standing amongst Fellow Psychiatrists in Eastern Zone.
- b) Contribution to Research, Training and Teaching in Psychiatry.
- c) Contribution in the Organization of the Eastern Zonal Branch of Indian Psychiatric Society
- d) Contribution to the Service and Development of the fraternity.

V. A panel consisting of three judges will assess the nominations. The nomination securing the highest total marks shall win the oration award, subject to ratification by the Awards Committee and the Executive Committee of the Eastern Zonal Branch of Indian Psychiatric Society. The decision of the panel of judges will be final.

VI. The oration paper will become the property of the IPS-Eastern Zonal Branch and shall be published in the Eastern Journal of Psychiatry with editorial correction, if required.

VII. The speaker has the liberty to choose the topic in consultation with the Chairperson, Award Committee and the President of the Society. He/ She shall intimate the title of the Oration with a brief summary to the Chairperson, Award Committee and President, at least three months before the delivery of the oration.

VIII. No person shall be nominated for the Award after once winning the Award.

IX. If no nomination is received by the stipulated date, the Executive Committee of IPS, Eastern Zone will have the power to nominate any Life Fellow of the society above the age of 45 years for the oration.

DR. R. B. DAVIS ORATION AWARD

This Oration Award is instituted in memory of late Dr. R. B. Davis, a senior fellow of the society. Name of any Life Fellow of the Society who is not over 45 years of age on 30th June of the year of nomination may be proposed by any Life Fellow of the Society.



Rules for the Oration award are as follows

- i. Any Life Fellow of the Society can propose the name of any other Life Fellow of the Society who is not over 45 years of age on 30th June of the year.
- ii. The Oration will be declared one year in advance at every Annual Conference. The oration is to be presented at the subsequent Annual Conference of the IPS Eastern Zonal Branch.
- iii. No fellow of the Society who is over 45 years of age on the stipulated date can be nominated for the Award.
- iv. The proposal including age proof and soft copies of the bio data of the nominee must be submitted send to the email id and WhatsApp account of The Chairman, Awards Committee, IPS, East Zone, Dr. Rajesh Kumar, email id - **kartavyarajesh2003@gmail.com** • **+91 9871554629**

Last date of submission – **15th September 2023**

The nomination must be accompanied by written consent of the nominee.

 - d) Contribution to the service and development in the fraternity
- vi. A panel of three judges shall rate the nominations. The nomination securing the highest total marks (out of 50) shall be eligible for presentation, subject to ratification by the Awards Committee and the Executive Committee of the Eastern Zonal Branch of Indian Psychiatric Society. The decision of the panel of judges will be final.
- vii. The oration paper will become the property of the IPS-Eastern Zonal Branch and shall be published in the Eastern Journal of Psychiatry with editorial corrections, if required.
- viii. If no nomination is received by the stipulated date, the Executive Committee of IPS, Eastern Zone will have the power to nominate any Life Fellow of the society below the age of 45 years for the oration.
- ix. No person shall be nominated for the Award after once winning the Award.

1. If there is more than one author, the name of the presenter should be clearly mentioned. Mobile number and email id should be properly mentioned.
2. The content of abstract for the free papers should be described under the headings of Introduction, Aims and Objectives, Methodology, Results and Conclusion
3. Time allowed for presentation will be 8 minutes to be followed by 2 minutes of discussion.
4. Presenter of the paper and at least 50 percent of the authors of the paper should be the member of IPS Eastern Zonal Branch.
5. The participants must register for the conference as per laid down criteria.

Rules for the e - Poster Presentation are as follows

1. Poster needs to be presented in E-Poster format only.
2. File format should be PowerPoint (.PPT).
3. Total size of the presentation should not exceed 10MB.
4. Maximum number of slides per E-poster: 3 (Three).
5. All slides should be in landscape format preferably in 16:9 orientation.
6. Animation/movies/sounds will not be supported; please submit a static PPT format only.
7. The presenting author should report at the venue in time and must be present throughout the specified duration of the poster session.
8. Time allowed for presentation will be 3 minutes to be followed by 2 minutes of discussion.
9. The participants must be registered with Indian Psychiatric Society and register in the conference as per laid down criteria.

PLACES TO VISIT IN AND AROUND GANGTOK



Tsomgo Lake (Changu Lake):

A glacial lake located about 40 kilometers from Gangtok, Tsomgo Lake is known for its breathtaking beauty, especially during the winter when it is frozen. Visitors can enjoy yak rides and take in the stunning views of the surrounding mountains.

Nathula Pass:

Situated at an altitude of 4,310 meters, Nathula Pass is a historic trading route between India and Tibet. It offers panoramic views of the Himalayas and is an important border crossing between India and China (permit required).



Rumtek Monastery:

One of the most important and largest monasteries in Sikkim, Rumtek Monastery is home to a rich collection of religious artifacts, ancient manuscripts, and intricate murals.

Enchey Monastery:

Located near Gangtok, this 200-year-old monastery is known for its religious significance and traditional architecture.





Ganesh Tok and Hanuman Tok:

These two viewpoints offer stunning vistas of the surrounding mountains and the Gangtok town.

Tashi Viewpoint:

Yumthang - The Gorgeous Flower Valley:

Do Drul Chorten Stupa:

Located in Bulbulay, this zoo houses various endangered species, including the Red Panda and Snow Leopard.
